Copia closes \$20 million Series C extension

Kenyan logistics company, <u>Copia Global</u>, has closed a \$20 million USD Series C extension round led. Participants in the round included <u>Enza Capital</u>, <u>LGT</u>, <u>Goodwell Investments</u>, the <u>International Development Finance Corporation</u> (DFC), <u>DEG</u>, <u>Elea</u>, <u>Perivoli Foundation</u>, and <u>Sorenson Foundation</u>.

Founded by Tracey Turner and Jonathan Lewis in 2013, Copia Global is a B2C e-commerce platform allowing consumers to order and receive goods. The latest funding round will support increased sales via the mobile app.



This news comes after the announcement of a new partnership with Visa. Prior to this, Copia Global has raised a total of \$103 million USD in disclosed funding. The last round was a \$50 million USD Series C round in January of 2022.





Chart of the week
