This week, we head south for a mobility deal, north to Tunisia for an early-stage raise, and we spotlight a South African e-commerce and retail startup.

GoMetro closes \$11 million Series A

South African transport and logistics startup, <u>GoMetro</u>, has secured \$11 million USD in a Series A funding round led by <u>Zenobē</u>. Other participants in the round include <u>FutureGrowth Asset Managers</u>, 4 Decades Capital, <u>Hlayisani Capital</u>, <u>Tritech</u> <u>Global</u>, <u>Kalon Venture Partners, ESquared Ventures</u> and angel, <u>Greg Fury</u>. GoMetro was founded in 2014 by <u>Justin Coetzee</u> and offers a platform supporting the digitisation of transport operations. The funding will support the integration of more vehicles on the SaaS fleet management platform.



The latest funding brings GoMetro's total to \$12 million USD in disclosed funding since their launch. The last round was a \$1 million USD seed round announced in May 2022.

Tunisia's Cynoia secures \$930k in new funding

<u>Cynoia</u>, a Tunisian collaborative business tool, has secured \$930,000 USD in funding. The round featured participation from <u>United Gulf Financial Services</u>, <u>216 Capital Ventures</u>, and <u>Bpifrance</u>.

Founded in 2022 by <u>Nassreddine Riahi</u> and <u>Ayoub Rabeh</u>, Cynoia offers a platform featuring project management, file sharing, and communication tools to support collaboration. The funding will support expansion to West African markets including Senegal and Côte d'Ivoire.

FrontEdge closes \$10 million venture round

Nigerian FinTech, <u>FrontEdge</u>, has closed \$10 million USD in a debt financing and equity round. The funding round was led by <u>TLG Capital</u> and included participation from <u>Flexport</u>. The split between equity and debt financing was not disclosed.

Founded in 2021 by <u>Moni Alli</u>, FrontEdge offers tools for importers and exporters tools to support trade that include financing, cross-border payments, and logistics management. The new funding will go towards growing their reach.




Chart of the week
